Realize your dream home

In Suomussalmi, having your own home by the lake is not just a dream. There are opportunities for building a home or cottage both in planned areas near services and in the tranquility of the wilderness. Available plots are sold by the municipality of Suomussalmi, Laatumaa, and private plot owners.

The coves of Lake Kiantajärvi in Ahonranta and Vaamanniemi are excellent building sites just a short distance from the new comprehensive school in Ruukinkangas and the services of Ämmänsaari town center. With the change in the detailed plan, the plots in Merkkivirta, previously designated for recreational living, will also be available for single-family home construction in 2025. The sunny slope plots in the beautiful sand ridge landscapes of Vuokinjoki are located close to the town center's services. The plots are equipped with water and sewer pipes as well as electricity networks at the boundary.

The essentials for a good life

Suomussalmi is a safe place for children to grow up, and here, families with children have everything they need for a good and functional everyday life.

The new school, smoothly operating daycare with familiar caregivers, small class sizes, free childcare assistance for families with toddlers, and a wide range of free or affordable club activities and sports hobbies ensure the well-being of both children and their parents in the community.

In addition to the municipality, club activities are organized by the 4H association, the church, and local sports clubs such as Suomussalmi Rasti and Suomussalmi Palloseura. Alongside clubs, the Kiannon Kuohut spa is also popular among children.

Great facilities for studying

The Ruukinkangas school, completed in 2022, is located right in the center of the municipality. In addition to elementary school classes, the same building will also host Suomussalmi High School in the future. For children and youth, the school offers comfortable facilities with small class sizes, promoting learning and well-being. Outside of school hours, the facilities are actively used by various hobby groups, benefiting all residents.

The construction of the school follows the Healthy House criteria, and its design focuses on durable and energy-efficient solutions. The adaptable spaces of the school accommodate various types of activities, and special attention has been paid to acoustic considerations in the choice of interior materials.











In Suomussalmi, it's possible to live either in peace close to wilderness or in a more compact village center. Our twenty or so villages offer opportunities for living amidst the wilderness. Approximately 30 percent of our municipality's population resides in these villages, and during the summer, the population swells with holidaymakers, sometimes tripling in size.

Village associations play a significant role in maintaining and developing village life, organizing various activities and events throughout the year. Active village associations include Hossa, Kianta, Lappi, Myllylahti, Näljänkä, Pesiökylä, Piispajärvi, Pyhäkylä, Raate, Ruhtinansalmi, Vuokki, and Vääkiö.

For those preferring a more compact living environment, Suomussalmi also offers the Ämmänsaari town center. Within walking or cycling distance, you'll find all the essential services for daily life, such as shops, schools, and daycare centers. We have options to suit every dream and life situation.

Communal Suomussalmi

In addition to village associations, many other organizations host activities open to all residents. From the diverse offerings, everyone can find suitable activities and opportunities for participation and networking. Below are examples of active associations.

THE VUOKKI VILLAGE ASSOCIATION organizes activities for the benefit of the residential area and its residents. The association offers various hobby and recreational activities.

THE PESIÖ VILLAGE ASSOCIATION arranges events, recreational activities, and gatherings at the village hall. Additionally, the association maintains a local hiking trail.

SUOMUSSALMEN PALLOSEURA focuses mainly on football and ice hockey. The active club offers activities for players of all ages.

SUOMUSSALMEN RASTI welcomes participants to various sports such as frisbee, skiing, climbing, dance, gymnastics, baseball, orienteering, triathlon, and athletics.

4H SUOMUSSALMI provides hobby activities for children and youth. In addition to ongoing club activities, 4H offers camps and courses.

SUOMUSSALMEN NÄYTTÄMÖYHDISTYS RY is a society for theater and film enthusiasts, maintaining the Theatre Retikka and summer theater and screening films at KinoRetikka.

SUOMUSSALMEN SAMOOJAT is a member association of the Finnish Hiking Association, organizing various enjoyable outdoor activities.
