- specialists in different fields who work in management and management support.

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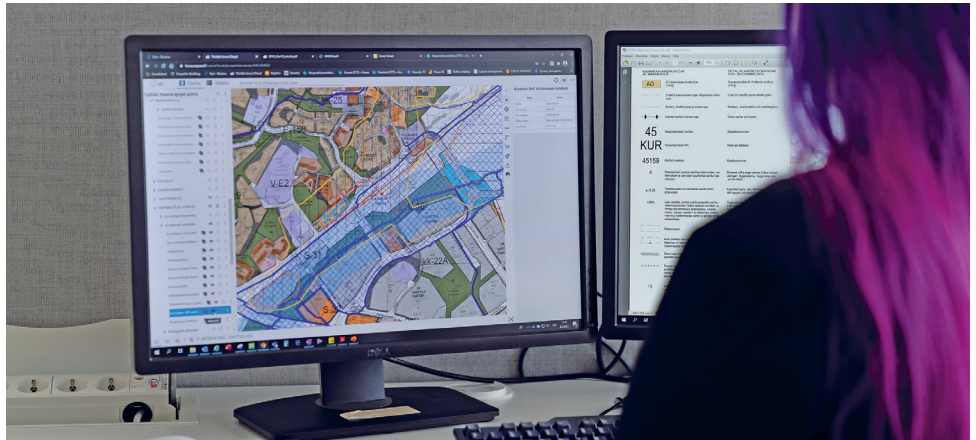
URBAN ENVIRONMENT SECTOR
