Families with small children appreciate the peaceful growth environment in Muonio, with lots of space to breathe and play. Starting in early childhood education, children learn to take others and nature into account, and these same values are also taught in school. As they grow older, they can continue their studies in the local general upper secondary school or vocational school. In addition to standard courses, the Muonio general upper secondary school and Lappia Vocational College offer coaching in skiing and backcountry skiing.

Muonio's free time options are a good match to any larger town. Nature offers many experiences, such as skiing, hiking and cycling in the national park or canoeing on River Tornion-Muonionjoki, which is the longest free-flowing river in Europe.

We also have a library, a cinema, a folk college, two ski resorts and much more. In addition, numerous active associations organise free time activities of all kinds in the area.

Companies in the natural products industry are inspired by local nature, refining berries, herbs and other local

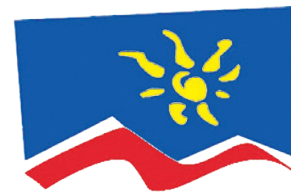
