





Would you like to be an entrepreneur?

Entrepreneurship is an opportunity for everyone. Entrepreneurship offers an opportunity to pursue self-employment and practise a profession without supervisory monitoring and control. For a part-time entrepreneur, it also offers the opportunity to earn extra income in addition to paid employment.

Entrepreneurship is based on a workable business idea. Once you have an idea, we can refine it with you with the help of our collaboration network. Anyone who wants to be an entrepreneur must have an appropriate capacity for risk-taking and also a good personal and financial situation in life.







Choose the right form of business

It is worth paying attention when choosing the form of your business. In Finland, the possible forms of business include private entrepreneur (i.e. a private trader), general partnership, limited partnership and limited liability company, as well as cooperative and branch of a foreign company. In addition, alternative forms of entrepreneurship include, for example, working as a so-called light entrepreneur or as a franchisee.



Private entrepreneur

The simplest form of business is working as a private entrepreneur, i.e. as a private trader. As a form of business, private trader entrepreneurship is tied to the entrepreneur and the business cannot have more than one founder. No seed capital is needed. A private trader is personally liable for all the debts and obligations of their business.

Limited liability company

The ownership of a limited liability company is based on shares in the company. The ownership, decision-making power, responsibilities and financial risk of the company can be clearly determined by the shares. Debts and commitments may be taken in the name of a limited liability company and no one is personally liable for them. A limited liability company is a good form of business for companies with operations aimed at moderate growth. The establishment of a limited liability company requires a share capital of at least EUR 2,500.

General partnership and limited partnership

General partnership and limited partnership are also partnerships. They differ from a private trader by the fact that there can and must be at least two founders. As with the private trader, all the owners (except the silent owners in a limited partnership) are personally liable for the company's debts and obligations. The establishment of a general partnership and a limited partnership can be achieved by a paper notification, and there are no seed capital requirements.

Co-operative association


A co-operative association is a company owned by its members. Therefore, a co-operative is not a profit-making company in the traditional sense, but its purpose is to provide benefits to its members.

How to get funding

Starting a business almost always requires money. The amount of initial investment depends on the business idea and varies widely across industries. The need for financing and sources of money will be determined in a financial statement when preparing the business plan.

Examples of sources of money include:

START-UP GRANT FROM THE TE OFFICE

A start-up grant secures the entrepreneur's livelihood for the time it takes to start and consolidate a business; however, it lasts for a maximum of 12 months. You can get a start-up grant: if you are an unemployed job seeker; if you are not unemployed, but you are setting up as a full-time entrepreneur after a period in paid employment, education or domestic work; or if you are a part-time entrepreneur and you are planning to become a full-time entrepreneur.

REGIONAL LEADER DEVELOPMENT
AND INVESTMENT GRANT

Business grants may be granted to small start-ups and rural businesses extending their operations. The purpose of the grant is to provide new services and jobs in rural areas and to develop business in the area. Grants will not be granted for normal company operations. An investment grant is granted for the purchase of new machinery and equipment, for the construction of business facilities and for intangible investments.

REGIONAL NOUSEVA RANNIKKOSEUTU DEVELOPMENT AND INVESTMENT GRANT

Grants may be granted to a natural person, a partnership or a community-based company in which the eligible persons have control and ownership operating in the Nouseva Rannikkoseutu area, situated in the North-Ostrobothnia. The company must have sufficient education or work experience in the field of application and provide the main livelihood to at least one entrepreneur or employee.



Finnvera is a specialised financing company owned by the State of Finland, which provides securities and loan financing for starting a new company, buying an existing business and expanding and growth of an existing business. Finnvera cooperates with major banks.

ELY CENTER FUNDS FOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

The ELY Center grants development assistance to SMEs' development measures and investments at the start-up stage, when a company wants to invest heavily in innovation or is aiming for growth. The focus is on the internationalisation of companies. The company finances at least half of the development project itself.

BANK LOAN FINANCING

A business loan granted by a bank requires, among other things, creditworthiness and existing collateral from the company applying for the loan. 
